Short Term Plan

- Larry and Carlos will coordinate with Sue Lavin, the Hot Team, Caltrans and the SF Police to increase the effort to make the area free of homeless encampments.
- Carlos will get Caltrans resources to raise up the shrubs along San Bruno Avenue so that the bottom of the area will be clear. The purpose of this is to make it harder for anyone to hide in the bushes.
- Carlos and or Larry will work on getting more lights in the underpass on 17th Street between San Bruno and Vermont.

Long Term Plan

- MUNA 17th-SanBruno committee will work with Julia and Sandra to engage a landscape architect to work with the neighbors to design a solution that will beautify the area and will make it safer.
- MUNA 17th-SanBruno committee will work with Caltrans Landscape architects to make sure the plan meets Caltrans requirements.
- Once the plan is complete, MUNA 17th-SanBruno committee will search for funding for the project, with SFParksAlliance as fiscal sponsor.
- MUNA 17th-SanBruno committee will work with DPW StreetParks program to get an encroachment permit for upgrading and maintenance of the Caltrans property.
- MUNA 17th-SanBruno committee will work to engage local businesses to join the neighbors in maintaining the new park and landscaping by scheduling clean-up work days.
