Dear Supervisor Cohen,

The MUNA neighborhood organization would like to request your help in order to solve a problem that has been plaguing the area for years. The problem is the encampments under the 101 freeway overpass at 17th street between San Bruno and Vermont streets and along San Bruno Avenue from 17th street to Mariposa Street. This area has a general absence of cleanliness and has brought a significant decline in the quality of living to the nearby residences as well as the general biking and pedestrian public who use the 17th street sidewalk.

We feel that this is a problem that needs a solution that involves a number of governmental agencies: Caltrans, California Highway Patrol, DPW, San Francisco Police Homeless Outreach, as well as the neighborhood.

Caltrans and the Highway Patrol spend a lot of money cleaning out the area, only to have it occupied again sometimes in a matter of days.

We would like to request help from your office in coming up with a complete plan that most likely will involve landscaping and re-fencing in order to secure the area as well as services to make sure the homeless have a better place to live.

Can we schedule a meeting with you or your representative in order to come up with a plan? We are available for day time meetings.
