Quick Update on Bridge Committee Progress

- The steering committee was most interested in improving the lighting. The objective would be to have the entire park lit up at night to discourage illegal activities in the park. Motion sensitive lights would be better than lights that are on always. The committee felt that the lighting proposals on the table were good, but we should not stop working towards improving the lighting until the entire park could be lit up.
- The steering committee thought involving the neighborhood and the HS kids in a mosaic mural on the bridge was a good idea.

Mini-Park Phase 2

- The committee was in favor of continuing to look for funding for the park phase 2 and will include it in the survey.

Other projects

- Electric wires underground and traffic calming will be on the survey
- Karin will talk to neighbors to get an idea of whether there is support for a San Bruno Ave/17th Street Improvement project. If there is interest we will develop a plan.
- Juan proposed that we have a barbeque in September

Bylaws

- There wasn't consensus on whether bylaws were needed. Consensus was if we have bylaws they should be simple. Bylaws also indicate to the city and to potential project funders that we are a democratic organization. An organization with bylaws is taken more seriously.

- Underground Electric Wires should MUNA pursue?
- Traffic calming improvements Utah and San Bruno Streets
- MUNA should try again to get the mini-park phase 2 completed.
