

## Fallen Bridge Park Short History

<b>Date</b>	<b>Activity</b>
1969	Bridge over 101 falls and neighbors on both sides of 101 work with their Supervisor Gonzales to make Fallen Bridge park on Utah St.
2004	Some one was attacked on the circular sidewalk and neighbors got together to come up with a solution. Formed MUNA. Met with Supervisor Maxwell
2008	MUNA wins first Community Challenge Grant and works with Miller company to build first rock wall on south side and plant mostly CA natives that don't use a lot of water
2012	After 3 Community Challenge grants, and more rock wall and a pétanque court, Supervisor Cohen gives us money for 2 lights
2015	Neighborhood joins the GBD and works with RPD to maintain Fallen Bridge
2019	GBD installs irrigation at Fallen Bridge Park, north and south sides
2021	GBD lowers the fence on the circular sidewalk and works with DPW to upgrade the chainlink fence around the sidewalk
